

GT 2018 Calendar Competition

The theme for the 2018 calendar is **Nouvelle Aquitaine**

Your pictures can be of any subject matter which you feel best expresses why YOU have chosen this area of France to make your home (or even second home).

The seasons, landscapes, views, local animals and wildlife & flora and fauna, French food, wine, markets, sports, heritage, cities, buildings, churches – in fact anything reflecting French life and French events within the region.

Each family member may submit up to four photographs.

Photographs must be in landscape format (rather than portrait) and your entry must specify where in Nouvelle Aquitaine each photograph was taken.

The closing date for submission of entries will be midnight **30th September 2017**.

Rules of Entering the Competition

1. The Get Together competition (the "Competition") is open to all fully paid up members of Get Together subject to paragraph 2 below.
2. By entering the Competition you are accepting these terms and conditions.
3. Four photographs per member are allowed.
4. Only LANDSCAPE (Horizontal) .jpg format photographs as generated by the camera should be submitted (not portrait format). Any photographs in portrait format will not be entered.
5. To enter the Competition, you must e-mail your name, and chosen image(s) to gtphotocomp@gmail.com
6. The closing date and time of the Competition is midnight on 30th September 2017.

Entries received after that date and time will not be considered.

7. You own the copyright to your Competition entry as its author.
8. By submitting an entry to the Competition, you give Get Together: **a.** permission for your entry to be published on the association's website and grant Get Together a non-exclusive, royalty-free, worldwide licence to republish your Competition entry in electronic format and hard copy for purposes connected with the Competition; and **b.** the right to use your name and town or city of residence for the sole purpose of identifying You as the author of your entry and/or as a winner of the Competition. Get Together will use reasonable efforts to assert the entrant's moral rights in the photograph. However Get Together may cut, edit, crop or arrange the entry as it sees fit. Whenever and wherever a member's photograph is used, the photographer's name and copyright will be attached to it.
9. Your entry must be your own work, must not be copied, must not contain any third party materials and/or content that you do not have permission to use and must not otherwise be obscene, defamatory or in breach of any applicable legislation or regulations. If we have

reason to believe your entry is not your own work or otherwise breaches this paragraph 9, then we may not consider it. You warrant and undertake that photos submitted will not infringe intellectual property, privacy or any other rights of any third party. You must ensure that any person or persons whose image is used in an entry has given valid consent for the use of their image or has waived any rights they may have in the image submitted. Where such person is under 16, the consent of that person's parent or guardian must be obtained. Failure to adequately demonstrate such consent may result in the entrant's disqualification.

Selecting the photos for inclusion in the calendar. After the closing date, all competition entries will be published on the GT website and members will be invited to vote for their 12 favourite images. The 12 photographs deemed to be the most popular by GT members will then be used for production of the 2018 GT calendar.
