As the AGM falls due, it is also time to organise elections for those committee posts where the incumbent has been in place for 2 years.

The constitution states:

At the end of their 2-year period, committee members are eligible for re-election at the annual general meeting, if they wish to continue in office. They are re-elected by a show of hands of the members present at that Annual General Meeting. Or by a secret ballot at the AGM, if more than one person is standing for the following positions: President, Secretary and Treasurer.

This year all posts are up for election with the exception of Northern/southern Coordinator.

i.e. President, Treasurer, Secretary, Newsletter Editor, Membership Secretary and Facebook Co-ordinator

President – overseeing the smooth running of GT, attending events where possible.

Secretary – Organising and taking the minutes at Committee Meetings – usually 1 per month, can be via zoom.

Treasurer – Keeping an accurate record of all monies into and out of the GT accounts.

Newsletter editor – producing the monthly newsletter and distributing via email Membership secretary – keeping an accurate record of GT membership, informing the NLE of any new members, dealing with renewals at the end of the year.

If you would like to take an active role in running GT please do not hesitate to talk to any committee members about what is involved.

If you wish to apply for election to any of these roles please contact the Secretary to ask for a nomination form. The completed form should be returned to the secretary at least 28 days before the AGM. This would be 19 January 2023

The Get Together AGM will be held at Le Chateau de Cherveux, Cherveux at 10.30 am for 11.00 am start, followed by a Bring and Share Lunch at 12.30 am.

All members who have paid their 2022 subscriptions are welcome and entitled to attend the AGM without giving prior notice.
